SCHOLARSHIPS TO BE AWARDED

The Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation, a New Jersey nonprofit corporation, (the "Foundation") will be awarding \$2,000 scholarships to high school graduates on May 27, 2009. There are two types of scholarships available.

Academic Scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievement; work experience; meritorious accomplishment; performance on SATs, ACTs or other tests designed to measure ability and aptitude for college work; recommendations from instructors and/or school principals; evidence as to the individual's motivation, character, ability and potential drawn from a personal interview; and form and content of the essay submitted; all as determined by the Foundation, at its sole discretion. Particular consideration will be given to students who demonstrate interest and involvement in community service, social awareness and humanitarian endeavors.

Arts Scholarships will be awarded based on achievement in the arts and the potential for success as a arts major in college. A brief (approximately four minute) audition may be required.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT

1. Please complete the Scholarship Application in detail. Please type or print the Application and provide as much relevant information as possible. Incomplete Applications may not be accepted.
2. You must submit a written essay of three hundred to five hundred words in length setting forth your "educational, career and personal goals". The essay is to be typed (font size of no less than 12) or printed. Include student's name on all attachments.
3. No scholarships shall be made to (1) any "disqualified individual" as defined in Internal Revenue Code § 4940 (d)(3)(B), including any Trustee of the Foundation or the Rotary Club of Haddonfield or a substantial contributor to the Foundation, or (2) any family member of any Trustee of the Foundation or the Rotary Club of Haddonfield, as defined by Internal Revenue Code § 4946 (d). Please disclose if any of these prohibited relationships apply.
4. At the end of the Scholarship Application is an authorization to release certain Student information by and to the Foundation in connection with the aforementioned Scholarship. The Scholarship Application must be signed by you and your parents or legal guardian(s) in order to authorize the Foundation to release Student information to the Student's school principal and for the Student's school principal to disclose necessary information to the Foundation.
5. Scholarship Applications must be delivered or postmarked on or before May 1. Applications shall be mailed to: Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation, a New Jersey nonprofit corporation, 15 Mechanic Street, Haddonfield, New Jersey, 08033.
6. Scholarship recipients must be available to attend the Wednesday, May 27, 2009, meeting of the Rotary Club of Haddonfield, and to read their essays (for Academic Scholarships) or give a short (approximately 4 minutes) performance (for Arts Scholarships). The meeting will be from noon until 1:30 p.m. and will include lunch; it will be held at Tavistock Country Club. Parents/guardians are encouraged to attend.
